

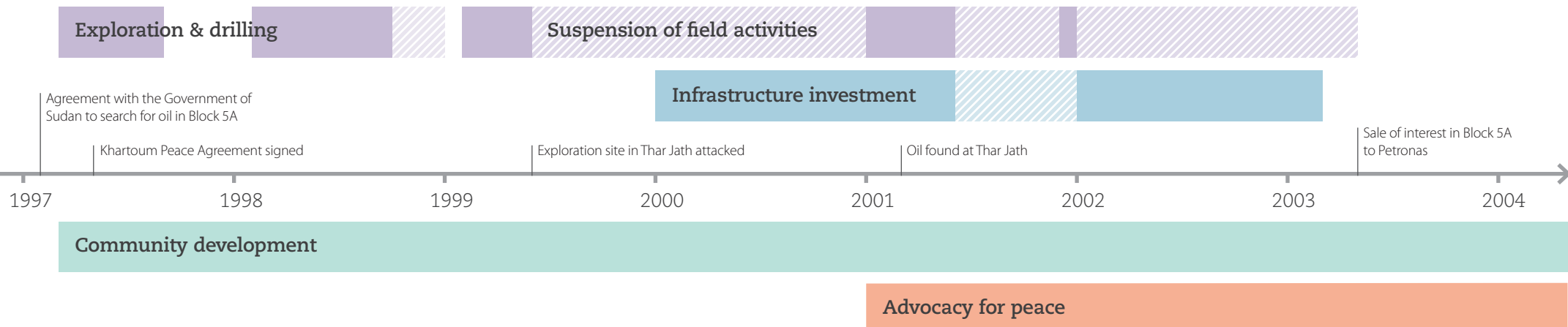
Lundin History in Sudan 1997–2003
